MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

The minute of the previous meeting was read and its acceptance was proposed Mr T Woodford seconded by Ms A Ramsay

POLICE & FIRE

No-one from Tayside Police was present at the meeting.

ROADS AND TRANSPORT

Very little to report, the deadline for commenting on Tayplan is approaching, T Woodford sent a letter backing the comments made by the Braes of the Carse Group

TWINNING

The "Dejeuner sur l'herbe" on Sunday 5th June was a resounding success.

Several residents of Inchture were involved in a visit to Marktbreit in Germany which is also twinned with Fleac, to mark the 25th anniversary of the twinning.

TREASURER

The funds currently stand at £899.52, which includes a grant from P&K of £498.49. The Special Project Fund has a balance of £10,137.13 including the £10,000 award from Big Lottery for the ICSC consultants report.

INCHTURE COMMUNITY FUND PANEL (ICFP)

A meeting was held on Monday 27th June. An application from The Inchture Rainbows was approved unanimously. A decision is still to be made regarding re-investment of the fund.

There is around £14,000 still available to be distributed.

INCHTURE COMMUNITY SPORTS COMPLEX

Not much progress is being made. The committee are unhappy with the feasibility study and are withholding a portion of the fee to KKP, this is still being disputed by KKP. Hopefully some progress and a definite direction for the project can be agreed in the near future.

PLANNING

An application has been received regarding the 2 houses opposite the hotel in Inchture, it is thought that this is a renewal of an existing application which may be due to expire.

An application was submitted for 2 wind turbines at Shanry in the Carse. A Ramsay wrote a letter expressing our concerns regarding this. The letter was to put down a marker for any future developments and is general rather than specific to this particular application. It is unknown if these will break the line of the landscape.

S Kelly-Barton is to contact David Scobbie, Finance Director at Muir Homes to discuss the money set aside for a MUGA in Inchtute.

BRAES OF CARSE GROUP

Comments have been submitted re Tayplan.

An objection has been submitted to the application at Shanry.

Money for the bird boxes project was obtained with the assistance of Douglas Calderwood at the Quality of Life Trust.

EDUCATION

Inchtute Primary School is near to capacity.

Abernyte Primary School still has 2 teachers.

It is unlikely the school boundaries will be altered.

PARKS & LEISURE and TREES & THE ENVIRONMENT

C Allan has received no response after writing to PKC to see if anything can be done to replace the fallen trees. She asked them to look at vulnerable trees as well.

There is a dangerous branch on an Oak Tree between Craigdallie and Ballindean. C Allan is to write to ask if it can be made safe.
