MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

The minute of the previous meeting was read and after amendments were made its acceptance was proposed Mr T Woodford seconded by Ms L McFarlane

POLICE & FIRE

PC Brian Simpson from Tayside Police was present at the meeting. He reported 1 crime, a break-in, which was of no danger to the general community as it was family linked. He asked those present to be aware of bogus workers, scrap metal thefts and thefts of farm machinery.

TWINNING

The next event is to be the AGM which is a dejeuner sur l'herbe similar to last year. This will take place on 10th June. An invite has been received to visit Fleac to assist with the wine harvest in October for a long weekend.

TREASURER

Internet and telephone banking is almost up and running. The money will be repaid to Awards for All in the next few days. Once this is done the bank balances will be £849.92 in the main account and £84.64 in the Special Project Fund.

INCHTURE COMMUNITY FUND PANEL (ICFP)

There have been 3 awards made.

- a) **Over 50's club** – It was agreed to pay everything excluding the hall hire. This includes the insurance as the panel did not wish to spend money on these items and not have them insured against theft/breakage. The panel would like to think that the club will be able to raise funds in the coming year to cover this cost in the future. Hopefully other groups will be able to get the use of this equipment and perhaps it will allow the group to meet on a more regular basis.
- b) **Inchture Church** – The panel agreed with the award of £1500. The money is to be added to other funds to carry out a feasibility study.
- c) **Inchture Village Hall - Tables** - The soundproofing was discussed and it was agreed that if the extra money was being given to the village hall committee from Quality of Life Trust to complete this work that the fund panel were happy to consider and approve the application for the tables. We were a little unsure as to what the figure of £500 contributed in kind meant. The decision was reached which agreed with the recommendation that we make an award of 50%, £1016.40.

It has been agreed that the £120,000 which has been set aside for the sports complex will be put into a high interest account for a period of 2 years to get a better rate of interest. It is envisaged that the money will be added to the funding for the school extension in order to build a sports complex which will cater for the needs of the local community.
