MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

The minute of the previous meeting was read and its acceptance was proposed Ms A Ramsay seconded by Ms A Ramsay

POLICE & FIRE

No-one from Tayside Police was present at the meeting. Cllr Roberts and P Henderson are to ask why no-one is attending.

ROADS AND TRANSPORT

The trees on the flyover at Inchture have not been cut back yet.
No response has been received to T Woodford's e-mail regarding the snow wardens.
There are a few pot holes on the High Carse Road which need attention.
The draft core plan has been produced, none of the amendments around Kinnaird have been accepted. The plan will be reviewed in a few years time.

TWINNING

A Beer & Curry Ceilidh Night is to be held in Inchture Village Hall on Saturday 25th February. Music is being provided by Banned from Abernyte.

TREASURER

The funds currently stand at £899.52, which includes a grant from P&K of £498.49. The Special Project Fund has a balance of £10,137.13 including the £10,000 award from Big Lottery for the ICSC consultants report. It is the intention to apply for internet and telephone banking to allow easier access to the accounts.

INCHTURE COMMUNITY FUND PANEL (ICFP)

A meeting was held on Monday 27th June. An application from The Inchture Rainbows was approved unanimously. A decision is still to be made regarding re-investment of the fund. It was felt that due to the slow process of the work to be carried out at the school it would be safe to tie the money up for 2 years.

There is around £14,000 still available to be distributed.

INCHTURE COMMUNITY SPORTS COMPLEX

The committee are still withholding a portion of the fee to KKP, this is still being disputed by KKP. It is hoped a conclusion can be reached soon.

No further meetings are planned until the study into the requirements of Inchture PS are decided upon.

Hopefully some progress and a definite direction for the project can be agreed in the near future.

PLANNING

Still no decision on the application which was submitted for 2 wind turbines at Shanry in the Carse.

The Delfort House application was approved with amendments.

There are no other contentious applications

The Local Development Plan will be published on 30/1/12. A meeting is being held in The AK Bell Library on Saturday 21st January to assist Community Councils when looking at the plan. A Ramsay is to attend the meeting. The plan includes approval for 16 houses in the field between Moncur Road and the A90.

The car boot sale in Errol has been extended to Saturday as well as Sunday.

BRAES OF CARSE GROUP

A meeting is scheduled for next week. It is still early days for the various projects.

EDUCATION

The feasibility study for Inchtute Primary School is to be completed in around 1 month. If the go ahead is given building work is not likely to start before 2014/15.
