**MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING**

The minute of the previous meeting is still to be written up.

**POLICE & FIRE**

No-one from Tayside Police was present at the meeting. P Henderson had a copy of the police report. He reported 2 thefts from farms and a problem with red deisel. There are also problems with migrant workers and local farmers will be made aware of these. Speeding lorries into the village are to be monitored.

**ROADS AND TRANSPORT**

There is still an issue with large bushes at the top of the Inchture Flyover. It is the intention to cut the verges once a year for bio-diversity reasons.

Cllr Roberts to investigate an issue with parking on grass verges in Glebe Drive which was raised by a member of the public.

Inchture Station Road is to be closed for 9 days from 12<sup>th</sup> June.

**TWINNING**

The next event is to be the AGM which is a dejeuner sur l'herbe similar to last year. This will take place on 10<sup>th</sup> June. An invite has been received to visit Fleac to assist with the wine harvest in October for a long weekend. The Community Council's former chairperson will chair this meeting.

**TREASURER**

Internet and telephone banking is almost up and running.  
The bank balances are £609.73 in the main account and £84.64 in the Special Project Fund.  
A letter of thanks was received from the village hall committee.  
The signatories on the bank account will require changing.

**INCHTURE COMMUNITY FUND PANEL (ICFP)**

## BRAES OF CARSE CONSERVATION GROUP

All 3 of the projects funded by Quality of Life Trust are up and running. 63 bird nest boxes have been sited and a variety of birds have taken up residence. A priority species (tree sparrows) have successfully hatched and the fledglings ringed and records kept and given to the BTO.

No more orchard trees or young trees for field boundaries will be planted until the autumn. Have been involved in the Tay Landscape Partnership Scheme (aiming to conserve and enhance some of the natural and built features that make our local landscape unique) and putting together thoughts on a project for funding. Intend to attend sessions organised by TLP re landscape characteristics and to be part of the Living Landscape Working Group. Hoping to get a share of a project officer's time to help develop and implement projects to benefit the BCCG area and are south of the A90 - "Tay to Braes Wildlife Ways".

## EDUCATION

Discussions regarding increasing the size of the school are still ongoing an announcement is expected in September.

## PARKS & LEISURE and TREES & THE ENVIRONMENT

Cllr Roberts is to see if anything can be done about the crows in Inchtute Main Street before next year.
