INCHTURE COMMUNITY SPORTS COMPLEX

KKP decided not to pursue the committee's decision to withhold a portion of the fee.

The study into the requirements of Inchture PS has suggested that 2 classrooms a general purposes room, an update of the meeting area and a sports hall and MUGA are required. It is hoped that the money set aside will be added to the money being provided by P&K and this will allow this work to give the community the sports facilities the ICSC have pursued

BRAES OF CARSE GROUP

The group are in the process of putting together a response to the Local Development Plan

105 trees have been planted with more to follow in the autumn

15 to 20 sites have been agreed for locating 120 bird boxes which will be monitored. A training day is being held to assist with what is required Further sites are being looked for.

The Orchard Project will run up to next March, some trees will be put into Abernyte PS.

EDUCATION

The feasibility study for Inchtute Primary School is completed. The study has suggested that 2 classrooms a general purposes room, an update of the meeting area and a sports hall and MUGA are required. If the go ahead is given building work is not likely to start before 2014/15.
